

RECENT RESULTS:

Falcons Cross Country finished 3rd Overall in 1A/2A at Sectionals and 10th Overall at the 1A/2A State Meet! Hunter Hartwell (3rd), Riley Goodson (6th) and Jacob McLendon (7th) all placed in the Top 10 Overall at Sectionals, with Hunter earning a Top 10 Overall Finish at State (6th).

Falcons Football extended their win streak to four games and finished the regular season (5-5) with a 28-21 come from behind victory over Cedar Bluff on Senior Night! Hayes Farrell had 2 catches for 45 yards and a TD while adding 12 yards and a TD on the ground. Kai Cleckler threw for 155 yards and 3 TD's. Bruce Downey had 5 catches for 45 yards with 123 tackles to lead the defense.

The Falcons advanced to the State Playoffs as the 3rd-seed in the Area, traveling to Appalachian. The Falcons season came to a hard-fought end against the Eagles, as Appalachian advanced 34-10. Ethan Bailey led the ground game with 62 yards on 14 carries, with Hayes Farrell leading all receivers (8 catches for 110 yards).

Lady Falcons Volleyball finished their season reaching the Final Four in Class 3A at the Birmingham Crossplex in the State Tournament. The Lady Falcons defeated Alabama Christian in the Elite Eight Round to advance to the Final Four before falling to eventual State Champion Mobile Christian. Outstanding effort Lady Falcons!

Kate Williamon, Callee Taylor and Sam Wakefield earned 1st Team All County honors, with Ryals Jones (2nd Team), Bentlee Pahman (2nd Team) and Ava Michaels (Honorable Mention) also earning recognition. Congratulations to all!

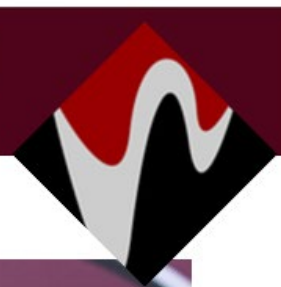

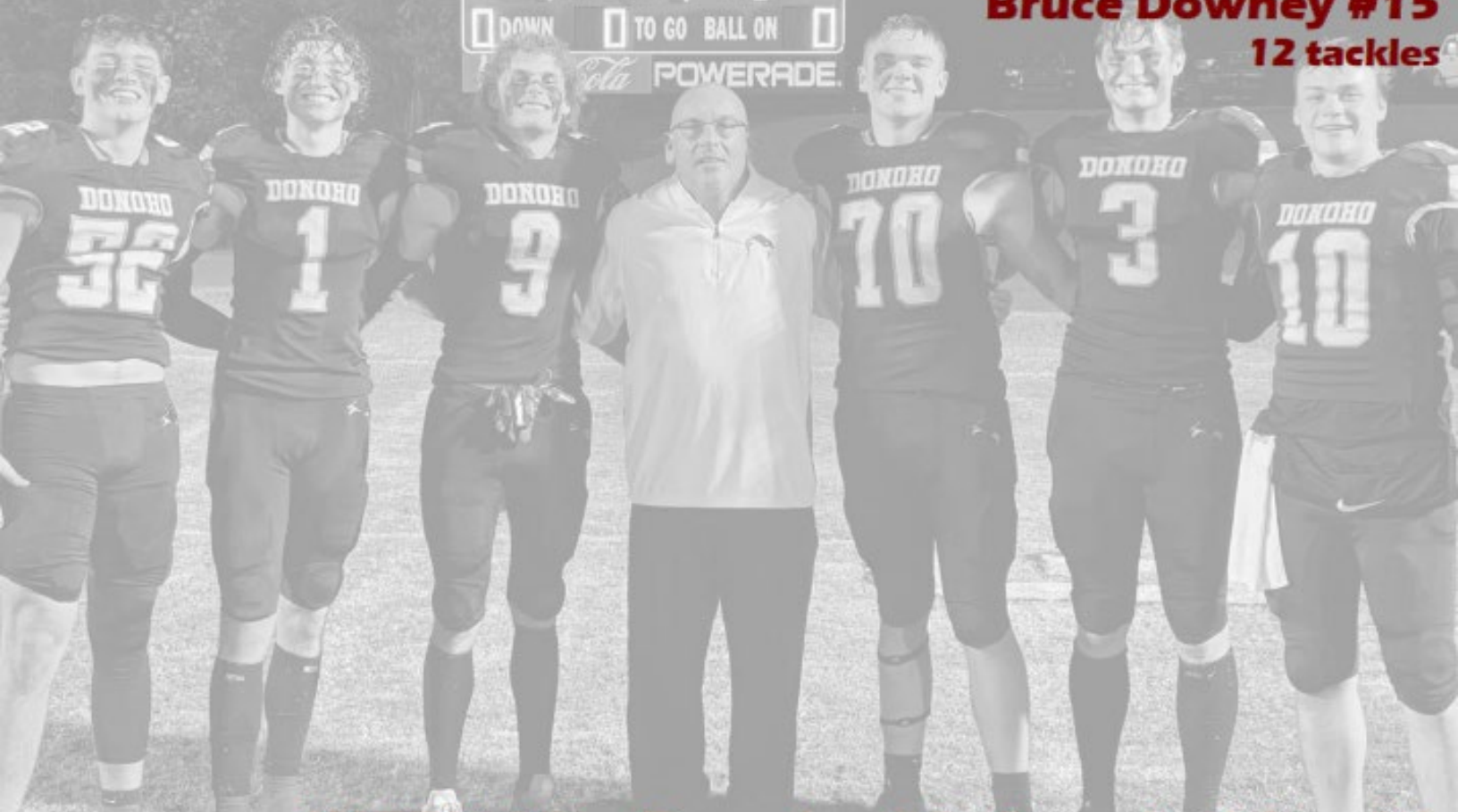
